Sermon Study Guide - April 9th, 2023

Today's Focus: "9f Jesus Lives..."

- 1) Thoughts to get you started...
 - Easter is all about Jesus' resurrection... are you sure Jesus rose from the grave? How can you be sure?
 - Why is it important that Jesus rise from the grave? What changes if he did not rise from the grave?
 - How does the question of whether Jesus rose affect your life here?... your eternity in heaven?

2) Today's Message: 1 Corinthians 15:1-7,12-20

Now, brothers and sisters, I want to remind you of the gospel I preached to vou, which vou received and on which vou have taken vour stand. ^{2}Bv this gospel you are saved, if you hold firmly to the word I preached to you. Otherwise, you have believed in vain.³ For what I received I passed on to vou as of first importance: that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, ⁴ that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures, ⁵ and that he appeared to Cephas, and then to the Twelve. ⁶ After that, he appeared to more than five hundred of the brothers and sisters at the same time, most of whom are still living, though some have fallen asleep.⁷ Then he appeared to James, then to all the apostles...¹² But if it is preached that Christ has been raised from the dead, how can some of you say that there is no resurrection of the dead?¹³ If there is no resurrection of the dead, then not even Christ has been raised. ¹⁴ And if Christ has not been raised, our preaching is useless and so is your faith.¹⁵ More than that, we are then found to be false witnesses about God, for we have testified about God that he raised Christ from the dead...²⁰ But Christ has indeed been raised from the dead, the firstfruits of those who have fallen asleep.

3) What does God want you to know today?
